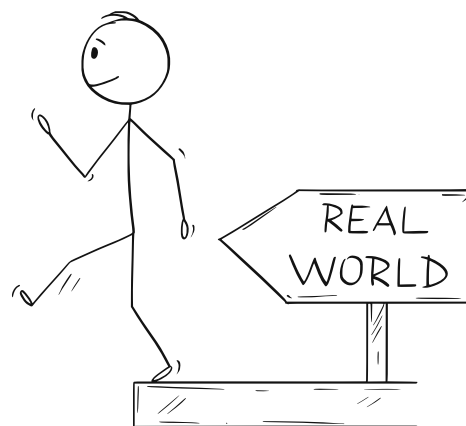

**HOW THE SYSTEM
WORKS: A SIMPLE
EXPLANATION**



"THE SYSTEM ONLY WORKS WHEN THE WHEEL KEEPS TURNING"

Think of the economy like a big wheel.

- When people have jobs, they earn money.
- They use that money to buy things – food, clothes, transport.
- That spending helps businesses grow.
- Businesses then hire more people, and the wheel keeps turning.



BUT IF TOO MANY PEOPLE STOP WORKING AND RELY ONLY ON GRANTS, THE WHEEL STARTS TO SLOW DOWN AND CAN STOP.



EVERYDAY EXAMPLE: A TAXI WITHOUT PASSENGERS

IMAGINE YOU DRIVE A TAXI

If people have jobs, they use the taxi to go to work and pay you.



You use that money to buy food, petrol, and maybe fix your taxi.

The person selling you food makes money and buys from someone else.

That's how the money goes around.

BUT IF PEOPLE DON'T WORK AND ONLY RELY ON A GRANT, THEY MIGHT NOT HAVE ENOUGH TO TAKE THE TAXI OFTEN. SO YOUR TAXI STANDS STILL. YOU CAN'T BUY FOOD. THE FOOD SHOP LOSES CUSTOMERS. AND EVERYTHING SLOWS DOWN.



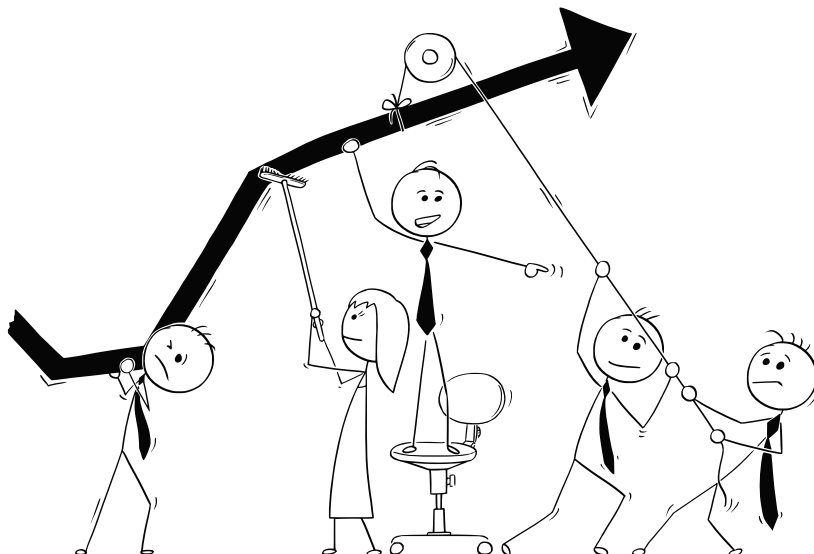
WHAT ABOUT GRANTS?

GRANTS ARE IMPORTANT — THEY HELP PEOPLE WHO REALLY NEED IT (LIKE THE ELDERLY, CHILDREN, OR DISABLED).

But if everyone expects a grant and no one works, then:

- There's less tax money to pay grants.
- Government can't help everyone.
- Prices go up, and people still suffer.

GRANTS ALONE CAN'T GROW A COUNTRY. ONLY WORK AND BUSINESS CAN.

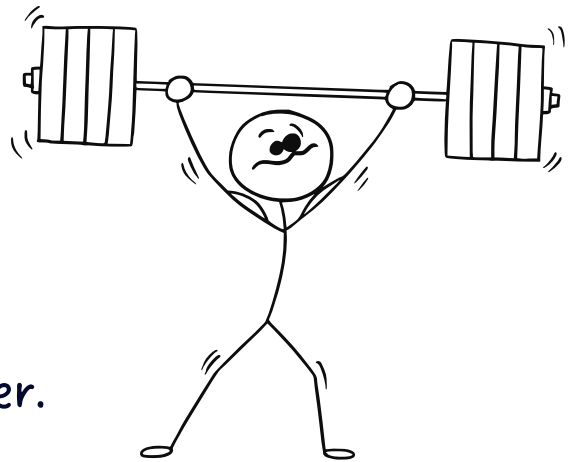


THE POWER OF WORK

EVEN SMALL JOBS OR SIDE HUSTLES HELP:

- Selling veggies, fixing shoes, washing cars – all of it adds to the wheel.
- One person working can feed a family.
- One shop can hire another person.

When more people work, more tax is paid, more money flows, and the government can still help the vulnerable, while the rest of the people grow stronger.
